



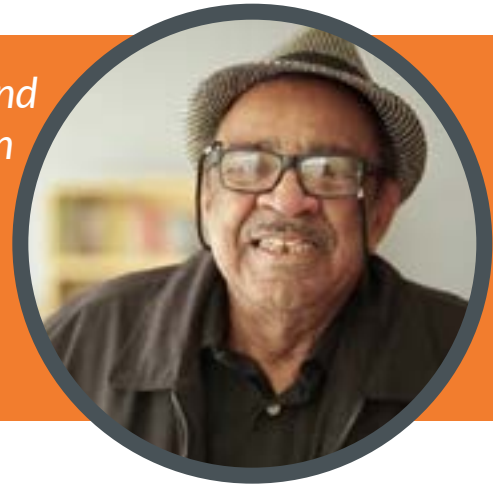
Fresh Starts, New Beginnings

Every day, Compass Housing Alliance works to offer a safe and caring community of support to help homeless and unstably-housed people find new beginnings.

Thanks to you, people like Mary, Colberg, and A.R. are able to navigate their way to stability no matter where they are on their journey home. Each year, Compass Housing Alliance impacts the lives of 10,000 individuals and families at 23 locations throughout the Puget Sound.

*"At the last apartment we rented, we were late with the rent and had to move out. If it wasn't for Compass, I would have been on the street. Compass has given me everything I've asked for. If I need someone to hold me up, **they've got my back.**"*
