CHOCOLATE DECADENCE

Alki's dense chocolate cake is in a single layer topped with raspberry jam and covered in whipped cream, rosettes, and chocolate shavings.

CHOCOLATE MOUSSE CAKE

Two layers of cocoa cake filled with a thick layer of semi-sweet chocolate mousse filling and finished with a ganache glaze and ganache rosette.

RED VELVET CAKE

Two layers of rich red velvet cake with a thick layer of cream cheese filling and enrobed in more cream cheese frosting.

BLACK FOREST CAKE

Three layers of cocoa cake flavored with Brandy and filled with a cherry butter cream filling is decorated in whipped cream with chocolate sprinkles, garnished with rosettes, and filled with chocolate shavings.

JAMAICAN RUM CARROT CAKE

Two layers of a special carrot cake with pineapple and coconut, flavored with Jamaican dark rum and iced in cream cheese icing, and garnished with carrots and hazelnut brittle.

TIRAMISU

Two layers of white chiffon cake brushed with espresso and Kahlua is filled with a mascarpone cream filling and decorated in whipped cream. It is filled with white chocolate shavings and topped with whipped cream rosettes and mocha beans.

NEW ORLEANS CAKE

One-layer of cocoa cake and a layer of white chiffon cake is separated by caramel and white buttercream filling, topped with deli caramel and decorated with chocolate doodads.

NEW YORK CHEESECAKE

Rich, dense classic New York Cheesecake is coated in an apricot glaze and topped with a rosette and hazelnut brittle.

MINI CHOCOLATE RASPBERRY CHEESECAKES

Twelve individual rich dense chocolate and raspberry cheesecakes are topped with a rosette and raspberry glaze.

MINI MOCHA CHEESECAKES

Twelve coffee infused rich and creamy mini cheesecakes are topped with luscious chocolate.

MINI NEW YORK CHEESECAKES

Twelve individual rich, dense classic New York Cheesecakes, coated in an apricot glaze and topped with a rosette and hazelnut brittle.

MINI FRESH FRUIT TARTS

Zesty lemon custard is poured into twelve buttery baked shells, sealed with an apricot glaze, and topped with a whipped cream rosette.

APPLE GALETTES

Twelve individual buttery baked shells are lined with vanilla pastry cream; then layered with Washington state fresh apple slices, cinnamon and sugar then baked until golden.

TASTING NOTES

The 2014 D2 has a notable dark ruby color with magenta edges. Tons of red and black fruits on the nose and palate, including blackberries, cranberries, raspberries, pomegranates, black cherries, and marionberries. Wrapped around these fruit characters is a presence of mint chocolate, black olive, cedar, toasty oak and vanilla. With bright acidity and good structure, this wine is extremely well built and offers a dollop of red fruit flavors in its lengthy finish.

The 2014 D2 is a gold medal winner at the San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition and was rated 90-92 points by Robert Parker's Wine Advocate.



In Loving Memory of

Garth Robert Douglas

February 20, 1965 – June 29, 2008

Garth was a handsome, well-loved child with a full head of auburn red curls. In his late teens he began showing symptoms of mental instability, which was later diagnosed as schizophrenia. He developed an addiction to drugs that lasted almost 20 years.

By the grace of God, Garth was arrested which led to his getting safe housing, prescription medication management, counseling and participation in AA and NA. Essentially, he chose help over prison. This gave him a second chance, and against all odds he lived his last four years clean and sober. Garth died from complications of a respiratory illness in 2008.

We feel that Compass Housing Alliance provides second chances for many people with a variety of needs.

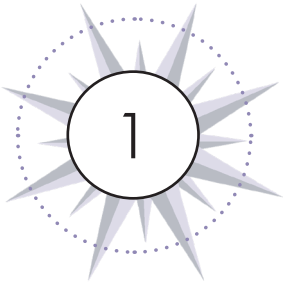
Auction Rules

Each bidder will be given a bidder number upon check-in. By bidding in the live or silent auction, each bidder agrees to the following rules:

SILENT AUCTION: To bid in the silent auction, simply write your bid number on the silent auction bid form. Designation of the bid you have written at the top bid is a legal contract to purchase the silent auction item.
